- ✓ Being a _____, such as a neighbourhood, city, province, or nation
- ✓ Citizenship is the condition of being _____ with rights, duties, and responsibilities as a member of a state or a nation
- ◆ Our government provides us with services and facilities, leaders and laws, it ensures our rights - _____ and it grants us citizenship.
- ◆ Being a citizen carries a variety of responsibilities and these duties can be divided into three major areas:

1. _____: *a person who is committed to democratic values and decision-making. A person who is knowledgeable about how the government operate.*
2. _____: *a person who is committed to political and social change within Canada. This person uses democratic methods to bring about change.*
3. _____: *a person who is committed to change at the international level. Someone who believes we are all interconnected and that the actions of others will ultimately affect us.*
