Your story must contain:

- A story that has a **theme and characters** and it should logically flow from one frame to the next.
- · A comic that contains at least 8 frames
- At least 7 images
- Use of captions and word bubbles frame
- At least 3 different conditions about war and/or life in the trenches based on your **theme**.
- Include on the top of your 1st page a Caption with the **theme** of your comic





You will be graded on communication, content and creativity in your story.
